

K3-2 - Lesson 15 - Honor

Behold, I am laying in Zion a chosen stone, a precious, honored Cornerstone. He who believes or trusts in Him will never be disappointed. **This stone brings honor for you who believe!**

1 Peter 2:6-7 (modified)

Father, glorify (honor, extol) Your name! To which heaven declares, "I have both glorified it, and will glorify it again."

God made Jesus lower than the angels for a little while. He placed his glory and honor upon Jesus' head as a crown. The Son of Man is now honored, and God has been honored in Him. If God is honored in Him, God will also honor Him in Himself. For when he received honor and glory from God the Father, a voice spoke out of the Majestic Glory saying, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased."

He is the radiance of the glory of God and the exact imprint of his nature, and he upholds the universe by the word of his power. After making purification for sins, he sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high, having become as superior to the angels as the name he inherited is more excellent than theirs.

The angel of the Lord said, "Why do you ask my name, seeing it is wonderful?"

Awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. Wonders were done because His name is wonderful!

O Lord, I will honor and praise your name, for you are my God. You do such wonderful things!

Worthy is the Lamb who was slain, to receive power and wealth and wisdom and might and honor and glory and blessing!

Therefore, God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come!"

Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to him who is seated on the throne, who lives forever and ever, the twenty-four elders fall down before him who is seated on the throne and worship him who lives forever and ever. They cast their crowns before the throne, saying, “Worthy are you, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they existed and were created.”

Invitation

Stand up and bless the Lord your God Forever and ever! Oh, magnify the Lord with me, and let us exalt his name together.

Read Aloud

Blessed be Your glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise! Your magnificent splendor and the miracles of your majesty are my constant meditation.

Be in awe before his majesty.

Be in awe before such power and might!

Come worship wonderful Yahweh, arrayed in all his splendor,

bowing in worship as he appears in all his holy beauty.

Give him the honor due his name.

Worship him wearing the glory-garments of your holy, priestly calling!

Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom and thanksgiving and honor and power and might be to our God forever and ever! Amen

Name, Naming

Song: “There’s Just Something About that Name”

To “name” something is to identify it, give it meaning, give it purpose, importance.

He knows us and calls us by name - Romans 8:30, Isaiah 43:1, John 10:3

A New name- Isaiah 62:2, Revelation 2:17 and 3:12

Legacy

Definition: something that someone has achieved that to exist after they stop working or die. Gift or inheritance. Names live on forever.

Exodus 9:16

But indeed, for this very reason I have allowed you to live, in order to show you My power and in order that **My name** may be **proclaimed** throughout all the earth.

Hebrew for “**name**”: shem – reputation, fame, **glory**

Hebrew words for glory and honor translate to either word.

Hebrew root for glory and honor: kabad – to be heavy, weighty, of great importance

If a = b, and b=c, then a=c

If name = glory and glory = honor, then name = honor

shem (rest of definition) - by implication honor, authority, character

...continuing with Exodus 9:16

Hebrew for “**proclaim**”: caphar- to score with a mark as a tally or record, declare, number

His name/glory/honor may be proclaimed/recorded/marked throughout the earth.

What does that “mark” look like?

Rom 12:9-21 ESV translation titles this section “Marks of True Christians”

2 Peter 1: 17

His name

OT – carried WITH

Exodus 20:7

You shall not take the name of the LORD your God in vain, for the LORD will not hold him guiltless who takes his name in vain.

Do not “take” the Lords name. “take” could be translated “carry”

Hebrew word is nasa': to lift, bear up, carry, take.

Hebrew word for vain is shav': emptiness, vanity, falsehood, nothingness, uselessness

Don't carry with you the Name of the Lord for nothing, making it useless.

Old Testament Overview

Gen 4:26 – people calling upon the NAME of the Lord

Gen 11:4 – humans want to make a name for themselves

Gen 12:1-3 – God's promise to Abram about making his name great

Gen 21:33 - called there on the name of the Lord, the Everlasting God.

Ex 3:14 – “I AM”

Ex 6:2-4- El Shaddai to forefathers (God Almighty..most powerful)
but Lord to Moses (Jehova/Yehovah...redeemer, self-existing, eternal)

Ex 33:18-20 – promise to Moses the Lord's goodness will pass before him and the Lord's name will be proclaimed before him

Ex 34:13-15 – His name is jealous

Deut 28:10 – Israel called by the name of the Lord

2 Sam 7-vs 9 And I will make for you a great name, like the name of the great ones of the earth. vs 13 He shall build a house for my name, and I will establish the throne of his kingdom forever.

1 Kings 9 – vs 3 I have consecrated this house that you have built, by putting my name there forever. My eyes and my heart will be there for all time.

They call on, acknowledge, ministered to, bless, sing praises, fight, gave words in the Name of the Lord.

God desired for His Name to be with His People. Tabernacle in wanderings, Temple of Solomon, 2nd Temple after exile.

Through a Nation God makes his name known: 1 Chron 17:21, Num 6:24-27

NT – carried IN

Jesus has manifested His name John 17:6

Jesus carried His name faithfully like Israel was supposed to.

Jesus came to us IN the NAME of the Father; John 5:43, 16:23, 20:31

Jesus came IN the name of the Father, so His Name could be IN us

To carry the name – God WITH you

To be given the name – God IN you

Jesus with you is Salvation, Jesus in you is sanctification.

Honoring His name allows His glory to sanctify you. Christ in you, the hope of Glory! (Col 1:27)

His glory is in us – unless you exchange that glory.

James 1:23-24 and Rom 1:21-23

Spread throughout the earth:

1 Peter 2:9 But you are God's chosen treasure, priests who are kings, a spiritual "nation" set apart as God's devoted ones. He called you out of darkness to experience his marvelous light, and now he claims you as his very own. He did this so that you would broadcast his glorious wonders throughout the world. His NAME IS WONDERFUL!

IN HIS NAME

You shall name him Jesus. (Matt 1:21)

Blessed is he who comes **in the Name** of the Lord. (Matt 21:9, 23:39)

In my name they will cast out demons; they will speak in new tongues; 18 they will pick up serpents with their hands; and if they drink any deadly poison, it will not hurt them; they will lay their hands on the sick, and they will recover. (Mark 16:17-18)

In my name, demons bow. (Luke 10:17)

Repentance for forgiveness of sin proclaimed **in His name**. (Luke 24:47)

Seeing signs and wonders, many believed **in His name**. (John 2:23)

Believing **in His name**, comes the right to become children of God. (John 1:12)

If you ask me anything **in my name**, I will do it. (John 14:14)

The Father send Holy Spirit, our helper, **in His name**. (John 14:26)

We are KEPT **in His name**. (John 17:11)

Faith **in His name** heals. (Acts 3:16)

Healings, signs and wonders **in His name**. (Acts 4:29-31)

Obedience of faith for the sake of **his name** (Rom 1:5)

Everyone who calls on **His name** will be saved. (Rom 10:13)

Do all you do **in His Name**. (Col 3:17)
